Tickets will be required in order to park on Freshman Field. (Tickets can be purchased when entering Freshman Field.)

Freshman Field and the baseball field will be open for tailgating three hours prior to the game.

Large quantities of alcohol will be allowed at the stadium.

Members of the athletic teams that use Freshman Field, please minimize the use of glass containers. If you do bring glass bottles, please dispose of the empty bottles properly.

At game time, both fields will be cleared by Public Safety and the Worcester Police Department. Individuals will be asked to enter the stadium or will be asked to leave the premises.

Individuals will be permitted to exit the stadium and linger on Freshman Field during the game (including half-time). The baseball field will be open during the game, allowing fans to enjoy the “Interactive Endzone” area.

Tailgating (setting up of grills, tables, etc.) will not be allowed on either field during the game. Individuals will be allowed to mingle/wind down with each other before the game. All fields will be cleared within one hour after the game.

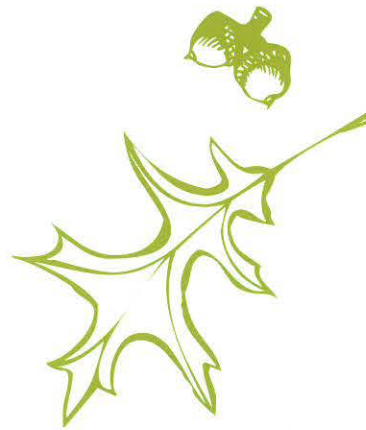

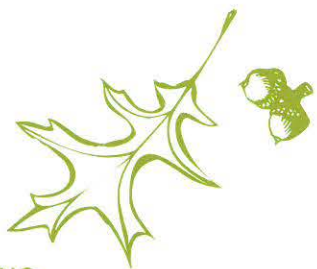
