Feb. 28. No. 3

My dear friend

I received your note  
last night informing me that  
you had been ill. Why didn't  
you tell of this before? I am  
quite vexed with you.

You say something  
about coming to see me.  
Well now is your time  
if ever. We will probably  
stop here some few weeks  
and I fear that warmer  
weather will find us in  
another native campaign.

I do not insist upon  
your coming because I fear  
you will not enjoy your visit  
but my dear, you will be  
welcome here if you think

well of it. There is, in fact,  
no use of me dodging the  
question, I will be glad to see  
you here. So come!

If convenient bring  
a riding dress although on account  
of the road it may be of less  
use. At any rate bring warm  
clothing - You must calculate  
upon a tedious journey. Come  
now or never! In Washington  
you call upon Capt. Parker of  
Gen. Martin's Staff and give  
him my compliments - he will  
furnish you with ticket on  
steamer and rail to Stonewall  
- Man's Station. If you write me  
as to your starting, I will have  
some one to meet you at  
Ogeena Creek. If you coming,  
Jennie, come at once -  
Yours etc. Spring
