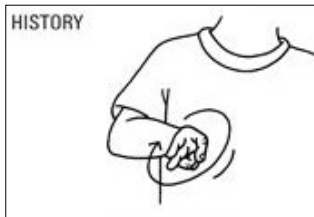

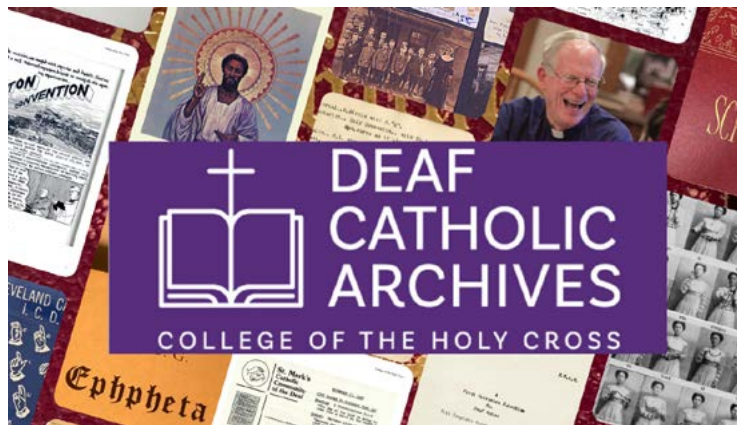

1. Type in: www.google.com.
2. Type in the search box: "CrossWorks Holy Cross."
3. Click on "CrossWorks I College of the Holy Cross Research."
4. Then on the next page, click on "Deaf Catholic Archives" icon (see image).
5. On the "Deaf Catholic Archives" page, scroll to the bottom of the page to click on what you would like to see: Deaf Catholic Archives, Newsletters, Scrapbooks, etc.

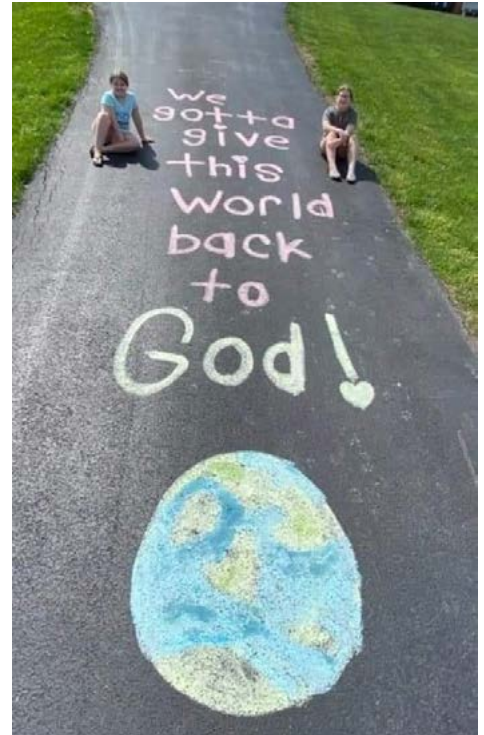
