Hig. House of Camp

April 18. 1868

My dear Jennie:

Yours of the 15th inst enclosing
photograph of sister Sarah, received this
evening. I like her picture very much
- she looks spotless, possessed of womanly
pride, and like one who speaks
with her whole nature, everything that
is not good and noble. By the way,
she seems to me a little puritanical
gentle ~~but~~ yet austere - like one having
fixed principles in life - yet full of
heart, impulses and soul. She would
find great happiness in the Catholic Church
I wish she were not a cold protestant.

I really am ~~not~~ ^{more} more anxious
about our little pet - poor little cherub!
tell me Jennie, that she is well, and,
as she says herself, "Gay and happy" again.
