I will be absent four days, but letters aning to are by mail will be sent out to me. My prof will be a little beyond that place that you and I code to the day if rained upon us. By the way Darling I have after thought since how cruck I was to unge you to ride faster that day when all the time you were Duffering pain, But I did not thenow if fore, and was afraid Good get wet on the way home hever mind will have a morning ride in patien other I will try and he reasonable, if not polite. There is no more yet and I still inhabit the house the deserted house. my little cap even left me. Mue flug still waves ones the bed - but there is in such cham in it as There was. Guiffen appears more friendly - he is now in Washington. Ener findly your Husband
