Camp - May 19. 1863

My dear Jennie

I wrote you some sort of a note last evening. I was quite tired at the time. Col. Aretzer who happens to command the Brigade now undertook to release Capt McE Ginnigh from close confinement without consulting me. To this I objected and told him if he persisted "I would resign my Commission immediately." He then revoked his order and concluded to let me have my own way. All right again.

I am just going over to bid Gen. Meagher farewell - he has resigned and is going home. Give Cookie a shower of kisses for me. No sign of move yet.
