Camp of Culpeper Va
Oct 4. 1863

My dear Jennie

I reciev'd two letters from you and a news-paper containing proofs of pictures. I have but a few moments to speak with you tonight. The pictures suit pretty well - but I do not wish you to incur any extraordinary expense on them. I wish you would have one copy of the one you like best, made, finished, and framed for ourselves. Let other order more if they see fit. Tell Capt. Phelps I received his letter and will write him again in a few days. To Plunkett & we have not arrived yet. Mahan came back to day restored to his rank. All well here. Gathor & Jan celebrated Mass here today. I like him very much - sure - why would not I? he is a disagreeing man. Our friends are well here. No sign of a either a move or a fight. We are living on the best of terms with all the world "the rest of mankind" and ourselves.
