

ABBREVIATIONS

In general, the abbreviations listed in *l'Année philologique* and *Numismatic Literature* will be used, with the following additions and modifications. Full titles are given in the bibliography and at the first citation of an item in the notes (except for book reviews). The usual practice thereafter will be to employ short titles for books and to shorten or, when appropriate, to omit the titles of articles while giving the journal references. To avoid potential confusion, I follow the style of citation of the American Numismatic Society for numismatic journals which have multiple series, giving only the year of the volume, and not its series number. For convenience, the most frequently used short titles of books are included in this list.
