Near Sharpsburg Md.

Oct 23. 1862

My Dear Jennie:

Yours of the 19th inst.  
received. We are preparing this eve-  
-ning to leave this place - to go whither  
I know not. I hope to victory, decision,  
final! I want the rebels whipped quick  
and eternally.

About lying house, you  
may do as you think best - I will  
approve. Be careful of shocks and  
mortgages. So you lost your ten  
rent; well, didn't I often tell you  
how I disliked to have anything to  
do with others in house matters of  
this sort. Let her go, poor creature.  
If she has got a son, I'll make  
Lizzie turn him sometime  
for the rent she owes you! Unless  
this prove prevent I can send you  
from six to eight hundred dollars soon  
- next payment I regret Mrs. Merills too  
- be very much. She is so kind and full of
