Head Quarters 9th Mass. Vol.
Camp near Falmouth
April 22. 1868

My dear Wife

Your letter of the 18th Inst
received this evening. Containing
slip from the Port. It really does not
amount to much as against me,
and so Mr. Smith's friends think - they
even say out here that ^{he} damaged him-
self by the letter. However, I have sent
the original of the enclosed copy to
Col. Greene of the Port - also one to Seale
with a letter. When I get home I shall
have a years business on hand sure.
Poor Smith will pay for his ignorant
and malicious ravings some day in the
future. But love, I must cut this
interuven with ^{you}, short since I am quite
busy, and have only time to ask you
for a modern kiss.
