Head Quarters 9th Mass.
Camp New Britain Me.
Nov. 15. 1863

My dear Jennie

Your very kind letter of the 8th inst.
came to hand this morning. This is the second
I have received of that date. It gives me great
pleasure to know that you & Louie are so well.
Indeed I had previously heard that you were
in the best of spirits. The Dr. told me of
a visit yourself & Capt. G. made to Chelsea.
I don't know about this sort of thing - but
you are the best judge.

We are again expecting a move - when
to etc. we are all in happy ignorance. There
has been some cannonading at the front to-day.
If the weather holds good I have no doubt of
a fight soon, and as the Army is in good condi-
tion - I believe in our triumph.
